



# STONEHEDGE BRACELET

*a.j. walker design*

## YOU WILL NEED:

- 5-7 grams size 11 seed beads
- 5-8 size 6m swarovski crystals
- 30-50 size 3-4m stone chips
- ball and socket snap
- 6lb fireline thread
- #11 bead needle

Cut 2 1/2 -3 yds. of fireline and thread your needle. place the needle at 1/2 of the way down the thread. you will be working with a double thread. place a stop bead about 8 in. from end.

step one: tail and stringing  
pick up 18 size 11, one 6m crystal and 2-11.

step two: chip sequence

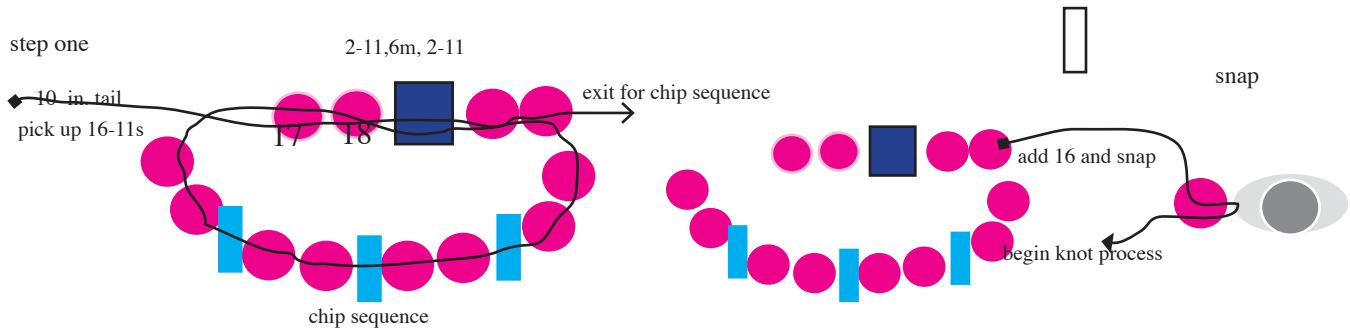
pick up one chip, 2-11, one chip, 2-11, one chip and 2-11. Take needle back down thru 2-11 (beads # 17 and 18) BEFORE crystal, 6m crystal and exit the next 2 size 11. pull snug against tail end.

repeat step two for chip sequence. exit the last two size 11s. pull snug.

hint: you can add as many chips as you wish. it will simply cover the crystal. i would recommend using a 6m round to cover.

step three: pete and repeat

alternating between the two steps repeat for bracelet length.



step four: clasp

once your bracelet reaches desired length you will add the snap. after adding the last accent unit you will pick up 16 size 11 and your clasp. go back down thru the size 11 sequence and begin knot process.

adding and ending thread:

Pull thread snug prior to beginning knots. Where thread is exiting make a gentle fold between your fingers. The area will be slightly lifted above your fingertips. Place the needle just under the thread. By pinching the area you will have more control over your thread. Pull on thread. A small loop will form. Place the needle thru it. Lay the needle down. Pull on thread until the knot slides up between the beads. Working away from the stop bead, Go thru several beads. Repeat knot x 2. Even after the last knot you will continue thru several more beads. This pulls the knot down inside the beads. Trim thread. Remove stop bead on second end and repeat process. Place a stop bead leaving a small tail on your new thread. Repeat process with new thread.
